Set in the vast gardens and forests of Hamamatsu Flower Park, visitors to the park can enjoy the seasonal spring and early summer flowers such as the 1,300 cherry blossoms, 500,000 tulips and 1 million Japanese irises as they go around the park. Visitors can also enjoy the ornamental displays of all sorts inside *Crystal Palace*, the large greenhouse in the park.

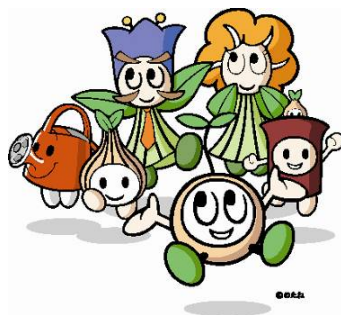
Hamanako Garden Park
