When you go to the hospital, do you bring your child to help you interpret at hospital, instead of sending them to school? We can send someone to interpret in place of your child.

## If your child misses school:

- Will fall behind classes...
- Will miss out on school lunches...
- Will have trouble moving up grades, or getting a job...



## If you ask for a interpreter:

- Your child can go to school and study.
- Your child can spend time with their friends.
- Your child does not need to hear about your sickness.

When an underage (below 18) child needs to miss school, to interpret for their parents.

## 【Time】 Two hours between 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. during any weekday.

Portuguese, English (Please ask us about any other languages)
