

Emergency Measures Regarding Hamamatsu City Designated Garbage Bags

Regarding 「Hamamatsu City Designated Garbage Bags (City Designated Garbage Bags)」, due to growing concerns caused by the situation in the Middle East, demand has surged, and in-store stock at some stores in the city is running low. For this reason, as stated below, emergency measures will be implemented for disposing of garbage using bags other than City Designated Garbage Bags.

In addition, regarding City Designated Garbage Bags, garbage bag manufacturers have confirmed that they are able to produce the same quantity as in normal years. To ensure that City Designated Garbage bags are available to everyone, we ask for your understanding and cooperation in continuing to refrain from excessive purchases.

- Basic rule is to use 「City Designated Garbage Bags」.
- If City Designated Garbage bags are not available, garbage may be disposed of using transparent or semi-transparent garbage bags. (details are shown below)
- Period: May 18, 2026 (Monday) ~~~ June 30, 2026 (Tuesday)~~
Until Wednesday, September 30, 2026, the emergency measures regarding city designated garbage bags will continue.
- Items that may be disposed of using bags other than City Designated Garbage Bags: 
 burnable rubbish, non-burnable rubbish, plastic containers and packaging (Plastic mark)
- ※ After the period ends, collection will return to the normal rule of disposing of garbage using City Designated Garbage Bags.

○ Garbage bags that can be used



- Transparent or semi-transparent bags whose contents are visible
- Size: 10ℓ to 45ℓ or less
- Bags that can be tied closed so that the contents do not spill out

× Garbage bags that cannot be used



- × Bags whose contents are not visible
- × Bags that tear easily, bags that allow liquid to seep out
- × Bags that cannot be tied closed
- × Other City Designated Garbage Bags
