**When:** From June 11 (Wed) -

**Certificate Type:** Income Certificate, Tax Certificate

**What to Bring:** A form of identification, such as a My Number card or driver's license (if you are representing someone else, you will also need a power of attorney form)

**Fee:** ¥350 per copy

※If you use the certification service at a convenience store, the certification fee will be reduced by 200 yen (MyNumber Card is required).

## Kindergarten for All

< こども誰でも通園制度 >

The Kindergarten for All System (kindergarten enrolment support program for infants) is a new daycare system that supports the upbringing of all children and allows **flexible use of daycare centers and other facilities on an hourly basis, regardless of the guardian's working situation**. Those who are anxious about raising their children or want their children to experience an environment different from that of home are encouraged to take advantage of this system.

**Available at 48 facilities in the city!**

### What is the Kindergarten for All System?

It is a system where children who do not normally attend a daycare center can attend once a day (2 hours) for up to 10 hours per month for a fee.

## Photochemical Oxidants and PM2.5 Warning

Hamamatsu City will issue a “photochemical oxidant warning” or “PM2.5 warning” if there is a rise in the concentration of photochemical oxidants or PM2.5 in the air which pose a potential health risk.

If a warning is issued, please follow the precautions below to protect your health.

Precautions in the event of a photochemical oxidants or PM2.5 warning	
Photochemical Oxidants Warning	PM2.5 Warning Information
Refrain from long periods of intense exercise outdoors	
If you feel any irritation in your eyes or pain in your throat, wash your eyes or gargle as necessary	People with respiratory or circulatory diseases, children, and the elderly should take extra precaution
Refrain from driving to reduce vehicle emissions	Refrain from indoor ventilation and opening windows
